

## Mounted Horsemen - Padstow Museum



Probably dating from the 15<sup>th</sup> century, these rare Mounted Horsemen, perch on the ridge tiles above the Market Place. The Horsemen were a sign to travellers as a site where a 'change of horses' could be obtained. They have survived the remodelling of buildings and even saved from destruction when thrown into a skip!

Tradition says that when the church clock strikes midnight the Horsemen descend to gallop around the Market Square!
